### Maturation

The grapes are machine harvested, de-stemmed and crushed. The must is pumped to a fermentation tank, followed by active dry yeast rehydrated. During fermentation, open pump-overs are made to enhance fruitiness, keeping controlled temperature at 26-28°C during 7-10 days. The pressed wine is kept separate. Part of this blend underwent micro oxygenation technique. Malolactic fermentation usually occurs naturally.



### Nose

Ripe and intensely fruity with red fruits, cassis, plums, and cherries.



### Palate

Round and medium sweet attack. Juicy and structured mid palate with cassis and red fruits. Clean and long finish.



### Food Matches

This wine is excellent with pork, lamb and roasted red meats pastas and cheeses. Serve at 16 ° -18 ° C
